By-Laws of



BATS Sports Club

1. Eligibility of players

- a. All players who are a member of BATS Sports Club and who have registered as a participant, are eligible to play.

2. Transfer of players

- a. Players may apply to be transferred between Teams participating in BATS Inclusive Sports Competitions. If the transfer is approved, a charge for the change of uniform may apply.
- b. Approval for a player to transfer to another Club outside of Bats Sports Club is at the sole discretion of the Committee.

3. Attire of players

- a. All participating players in any game organised by BATS Sports Club must be dressed in their authorised uniform, except in the case of new players who may need to wait until a uniform is provided to them.

4. Officials' duties and conduct

- a. Officials shall report in writing to a Committee Member of BATS Sports Club, any case of misconduct as soon as possible and not more than seven days after the incident.
- b. Officials should ensure that fair safe and reasonable action of play shall be afforded to all players.
- c. Officials are to ensure that players are properly and tidily dressed prior to the start of play and during play.



5. Protests

- a. If either Captain is dissatisfied with any occurrence during a match, they may protest to a member of the BATS Sports Club committee after the match. Captains are not to argue with the umpire during a match.
- b. The Captain shall initially notify their intention to do so by notating such an intention at the conclusion of the match and handing this note to a Team Official.
- c. All protests shall be presented to the BATS Sports Club Committee, in writing and as soon as possible after the game but no later than 7 days after the incident took place.
- d. The BATS Sports Club Committee shall be the final arbiter on all protests lodged.

6. Role of the Competition Association – BATS Sports Club.

- a. The role of the Association is to:
 1. Produce and manage the Competition Draw and register the Competition, participants, and the Association with MyCricket.
 2. Assist with the recruitment of players and officials.
 3. Form and Train teams for inclusion in the Competition.
 4. Provide match Officials for activities.
 5. Provide participants with the necessary playing equipment.
 6. Provide access to the Competition Rules and By-laws.
 7. Provide the necessary equipment.
 8. Provide a first-aid officer for each game.
 9. Provide transport for participants as required.

7. Role and responsibilities of the Participants

- a. Participants are to:
 1. Register as a member of BATS Sports Club.
 2. Attend training sessions.
 3. Abide by the BATS Sports Club Rules and By-Laws.
 4. Treat all Officials and Players with respect.
